

Download Manually Remove Acrobat Reader

The uninstaller is designed to remove everything Adobe Reader 7.0 installs. When you start Adobe Reader 7.0 for the first time, or when you modify the preferences, new folders and files could be created. This setting doesn't work for me. I'm running Windows 7 64-bit, Adobe Acrobat Reader DC (15.009.20071), no updates pending. Whether I manually hide the tools pane, and then uncheck this box, or even start the AcroRd32.exe via "Run as Administrator" and do the same, the setting has no effect on documents that I open subsequently. Hello Anand Sri, After updating to Adobe Acrobat Reader DC version 2019.008.20071, all corporate computers encountered the same problem. Have you tried printing other PDF files and checked or is it specific to one PDF? This document contains known issues and troubleshooting tips not covered in the Acrobat and Reader documentation.
