Spectrum. Black-body radiation has a characteristic, continuous frequency spectrum that depends only on the body's temperature, called the Planck spectrum or Planck's law. The spectrum is peaked at a characteristic frequency that shifts to higher frequencies with increasing temperature, and at room temperature most of the emission is in the infrared region of the electromagnetic spectrum. Sharia (/ ʃ ə r i ə /), Sharia law, or Islamic law (Arabic: شريعة [ʃaʕriʕa]) is a religious law forming part of the Islamic tradition. It is derived from the religious precepts of Islam, particularly the Quran and the Hadith. In Arabic, the term sharʕah refers to God's immutable divine law and is contrasted with fiqh, which refers to its human scholarly interpretations.
